

YOU CAN SURVIVE!

Revelation 13:17 describes a time when the beast power will persecute the remnant by imposing economic sanctions. How will God’s people survive? The book, **YOU CAN SURVIVE!**, is designed to help your family meet the challenges of the end times.

Church Seminars: Through the spoken word and inspirational sacred music the Franklin family address the urgent need of preparation for the end times. Sermon topics include: The Soon Return of Jesus (7 pm Friday), Restoration and the Time of Jacob’s Trouble (Sabbath 11 am), God’s Appointed (Sabbath 2:30 pm), The National Sunday Law (Sabbath 4:00 pm), When No Man Can Buy or Sell (Sabbath 5 pm), and Country Living and the End Time (Sunday 10 am). Books, charts, CDs and DVDs are available Sabbath evening. Hundreds of people have given their hearts to God as a result of this ministry.



Family Camps: Jere and Linda Franklin, their son Jed and his wife Amber, live on a large farm in the Peace Country of northern British Columbia where they share a common burden of teaching others the joys of country living as well as its significance for God’s people in the end times. Once a year they conduct a 10 day Family Camp (the first week of September) where guests harvest their noon meal from the garden and cook it on a wood cook stove. Each morning and evening spiritual studies are presented on end time events. Practical classes taught during the day include:

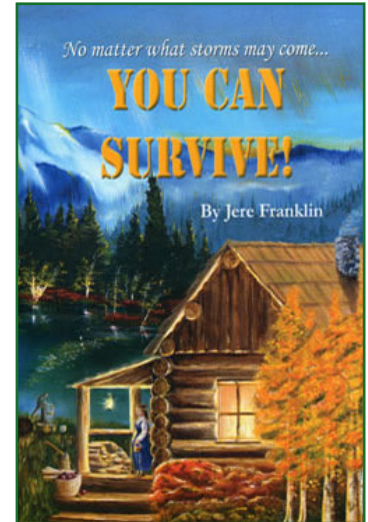
log cabin building, using a crosscut saw, shake-splitting, scything, grinding grain, greenhousing, gardening, building root cellars, cooking with wood, bread making, food preservation, making charcoal, hand methods of laundry, and using a treadle sewing machine. The purpose of teaching these skills is to prepare God’s people for the time of no buy-no sell described in **Country Living**, pages 9 and 10, *“Again and again, the Lord has instructed that our people are to take their families away from the cities, into the country, where they can raise their own provisions; for in the future the problem of buying and selling will be a very serious one.”*

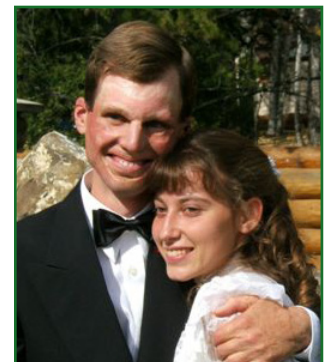
Procedure for requesting the YOU CAN SURVIVE! team to come to your church:
