Sanctuary Ranch Family Camp is over and left great blessings. Our group showed a lot of interest in being ready for the Lord's return. On our trip to Sanctuary Lake the group spotted loons and were blessed with their song from across the lake. There was a mirror image of the surrounding mountains and forests reflected in the lake. It was a true "wilderness experience" of peace and tranquility. We also experienced a beautiful display of northern lights to the enjoyment of our campers who were willing to abandon their warm sleeping bag at 2 AM.

We have just returned from our Eastern US tour beginning with our first US family camp in Wewoka, Oklahoma. The Tenfold Advantage Family Camp was held October 23- 30, 2011 at the Oklahoma Conference Camp ground was a huge success. Robin and Lisa East along with Rodney, Desi, Jessica, Alexi, Andrew and extended family, Gail, Charles and Kay, were a blessing in planning and implementation of the camp. Many of the participants committed their lives to God. Attendance hovered at 150. Family camp next year at Wewoka will be October 21-28, 2012.

Then we went on to Berkley Springs West Virginia, and then to the Review and Herald next for morning worship with the employees, after that was Olive Branch, Mississippi, and finally, Evansville, Indiana. Thanks to Rocco and Joyce Perrone in West Virginia and Carl and Bobbi Mobley in Indiana for their hospitality and opening their homes to us.

We made altar calls for people to recommit their lives to God without reservation and to give the impossible parts of their past life to God for Him to heal the wounds that have been made. *"If you who have engaged in this work of bruising and condemning have not heartily repented, then light, peace, and joy will not come into your souls. When you are careful, kind, and tender to your brethren in the same degree that you have been hard, unforgiving, and oppressive, you will confess your faults and make restitution as far as possible; and when you have done all on your part you may ask the Lord to do that which it is impossible for you to do--heal the wounds you have made, forgive you, and blot out your transgression. When there is so great reluctance to confess a wrong which is laid open and plain before the erring, it shows that they are controlled by their own untamable, unsanctified natures rather than by the spirit of the gospel of Christ" {5T 343}*. Hundreds of people responded favorably during these calls, and we thank God for the response.

On our trip to South Africa we had a financial shortfall of \$1100.00 (US) to our ministry in books which are now being distributed in that country. \$500.00 has come in to help with that short fall. Next year's family camp here at Sanctuary Ranch will be August 23- September 1, 2012. Mornings and evenings are studies of end time events. During the day we have practical classes including log cabin building, gardening and most of the skills we need for simple country living that will prepare us for the tough times ahead.

Two more openings for family camps have been initiated in the US, one in Arizona and one in Michigan. We are praying that God will open up other States as well. Our West Coast Seminar Tour, held on sequential weekends in Oregon beginning January 6-8, 2012 in Veneta, then to Coos Bay, Lents Church in Portland, and finally in Roseburg. We invite you to attend if you live in the area, and hope that you encourage others to come. Pray that our efforts are effective to get the message to the people, "Out of the cities."

Any monies donated to our ministry are not used personally. They are used for the expenses of travel from church to church.

There has been much discussion in our family about a reliable motor home for use in our ministry. It is sometimes difficult to find good food in restaurants and comfortable, inexpensive places to sleep while we are traveling; each night is a new bed. The expense of purchasing a motor home and the fuel cost and maintenance are balancing considerations.

While on the road, questions have been asked of us on a wide variety of subjects. Here is one question that has often been asked at our seminars during question and answer periods:

How can we do evangelism if we live in the country?

God's counsel makes it clear that the message to move to the country includes evangelism. In fact, evangelism is one of the reasons to move out. "God does not mean that any of us should become hermits or monks and retire from the world in order to devote ourselves to acts of worship," (SC 101). In fact, brothers and sisters, we should respond to the call that says, "The cities are to be worked from outposts. Said the messenger of God, "shall not the cities be warned? Yes, not by God's people living in them, but by their visiting them, to warn them of what is coming upon the earth" (Ev 77). God is encouraging us to follow His plan.
